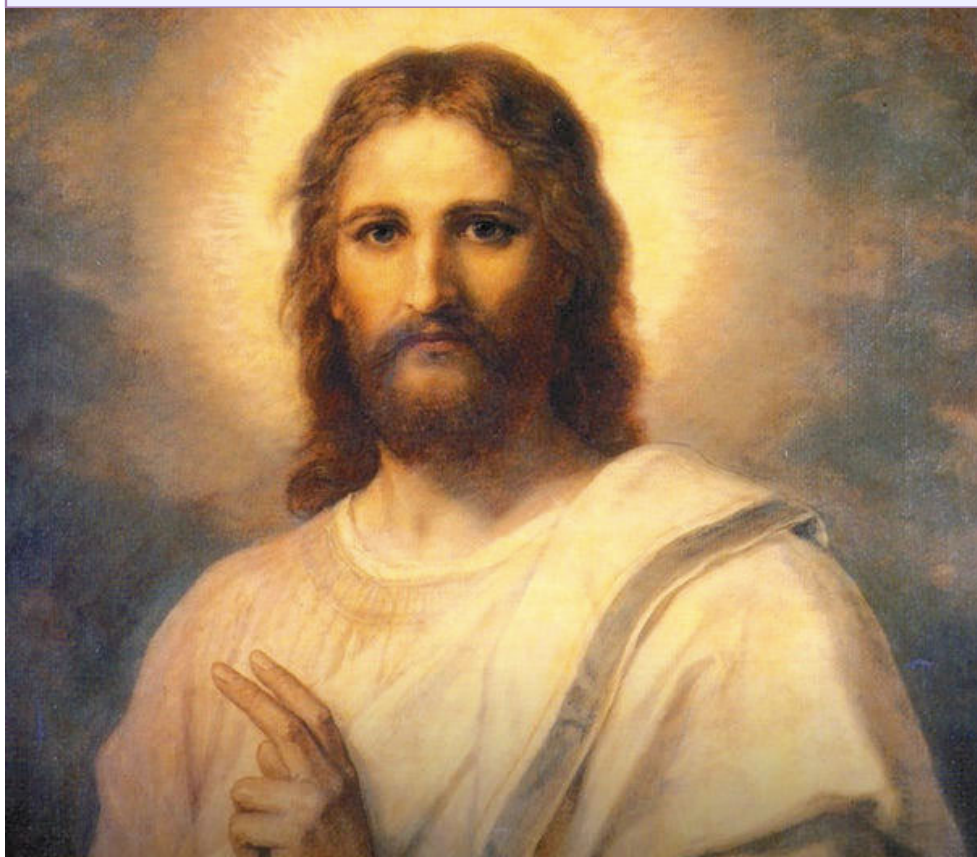

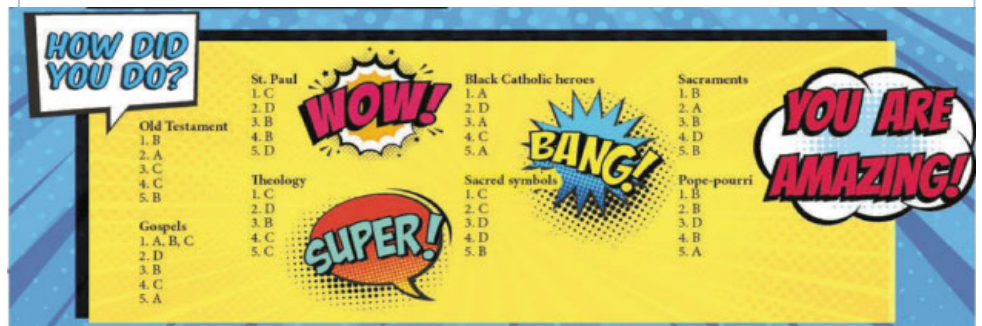

\$12,707.00 Priests Medical/Dental Insurance

\$55,952.68 Assessment to the Diocese for 2022-2023 Fiscal Year

\$95,002.68 TOTAL Amount St. John the Evangelist Parish owes Diocese of Owensboro. —SO.....some facts to keep in mind.....

\$1,826.97 is the amount taken from each Sunday Collection to pay these bills. Not to mention the electric, gas and water bills that we get each month.
